

DELIVERY OF ANIMALS TO THE FAIR

All exhibitors must show a copy of health papers to Department Chairmen at time of check-in. These must be presented upon request throughout the fair week.

All animals must enter the Fairgrounds through Gate 3 except horses which must enter through Gate 2, unless permission is granted by the Fair Veterinarian.

Dairy cattle unload at the Youth Show Arena as directed by the inspectors. Cattle are to get a visual inspection as they come off the trucks--**do not unload until directed. All exhibitors must provide a copy of health papers to Department Chairmen at time of check-in.**

Beef cattle, swine, sheep, and goats unload at their designated buildings. Horses will unload and be inspected at the trailer before being stalled.

Rabbits, chickens, ducks, geese, poultry, and pigeons unload at their specific buildings in other areas of the Fairgrounds.

Sunday – 9:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

NOTE: 4-H Dairy Cattle must be in place by 4:30 p.m. Sunday

BEEF CATTLE:

Saturday – 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. & 2:00 – 6:00 p.m.

SWINE:

Saturday – 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. & 7:00-10:00 p.m.

GOATS:

Saturday – 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Sunday – Noon – 5:00 p.m.

ALL OTHER SPECIES:

Saturday and Sunday – 9:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.
