Dept 38 Section 2

Division 1 - Long Hay only - 1 bale section at least 8" thick or an equivalent amount If cut from hay in the mow

1. Alfalfa or alfalfa grass mixed, first cutting. Not over 50% grasses
2. Alfalfa or alfalfa grass mixed, later cutting. Not over 50% grasses
3. Other legumes or legume grass mixture. Not over 50% grasses
4. Grass, first cutting. Mixture of timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes
5. Grass, later cutting. Mixture of timothy and/ or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes
6. Mixed hay, any mixture not classified in the previously, but contains 50% or more singly or in combination of alfalfa, timothy clover & grasses.
7. Summer annual grasses, Sudangrass, Sorghum Sudangrass, hybrids,etc.
8. Big blue stem grass, warm season, slice of bale or bundle
9. Switch grass or native grasses
10. Hops
11. Soybean Stalks
12. Straw
