Dept 6 Section 2 - Feeder Class - Individual

1. The market beef class will not be judged separately by breeds. Animals will be divided as equally as possible.
2. All animals must be castrated.
3. Beef weighing less than 900 lbs. will not be eligible for the Market Beef Classes.
4. Heifers may not compete in both breeding and feeder classes.
5. There will be no ear tags other than an RFID tag 4-H and FFA issued or metal identification tag from vet allowed in any cattle's ears shown in a market class. All farm tags, name and number tags must be removed before weigh-in at the Fair.
