

Department 49: Apiary Products

Entries will be received on Friday, August 19, 2022 from 2 PM - 5 PM and on Saturday, August 20, 2022 from 8 AM - 11 AM. All entries must be in place by 11 AM on Saturday, August 20.

All entries must be removed between 1 PM - 2:30 PM on Sunday, August 28, 2022. Doors will be closed at 2:30 PM.

RULES

1. All apiary products exhibited must be the product of the beekeepers and must be produced in Crawford County or adjoining counties.
2. Exhibitors should make every effort to enter extracted honey in its proper class. Assistance will be given to aid the exhibitor in classifying the honey for color as nearly as possible to meet the requirements of the United States standard grades.
3. Honey exhibits may not have any labels prior to judging. Labels: Exhibitor may choose to provide one label for each entry. This label will be placed on one item of entry after judging, by the chairperson. No labels may be affixed prior to judging. Labels should identify the producer and net weight as applicable.
4. All products must have been produced after September 1, 2021. The judge may open and sample any exhibit. One entry will be allowed per exhibitor in any one class.
5. Individual exhibits must be handled by the committee in charge of the exhibit. All collective exhibits must be arranged by the exhibitor, or their representative.
6. No exhibit may be disturbed or any products sold before the close of the show.
7. All honey baked goods must include 25% honey as a sweetener ingredient and must be made by the exhibitor. Recipes must be included. Baked goods must be wrapped in clear plastic, must be easily accessible by the judge.

Dept 49 Section 1 - Honey & Wax

Division 1 - Honey \$6, 5, 4

Classes

1. Light Cut Comb - 3 sections in clear boxes
2. Dark Cut Comb - 3 sections in clear boxes
3. Light Extracted - pfund 34 or less, 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers
4. Light Amber Extracted - pfund 35-50, 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers
5. Amber Extracted - fund 51-85, 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers
6. Dark Amber Extracted - pfund 86-114, 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers
7. Dark Extracted - fund 115 or more, 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers
8. Crystallized Extracted - 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers
9. Comb Honey - 3 square section (basswood, beeswax, half comb)
10. Chunk Honey - 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers
11. Frame of Honey in the Comb - 1 medium or Illinois frame of capped honey displayed in an enclosed case, any foundation.
12. Cabama Honey - 3 round sections. (Ross)

Division 2 - Beeswax \$6, 5, 4

1. Commercial - single piece of pure beeswax, not less than 3 pounds, no color added
2. Molded or Designed - artistic/fancy, not less than 10 ounces, no color added
3. Molded Candles – one pair, pure beeswax, no color added

Division 3 - Collective Exhibit \$10, 7.50, 5

A collection of honey or hive products made up for trade, gift or special event. This might include original container or labeling of interesting design. All hive products must be produced by the exhibitor.

Division 4 - Honey Products \$6, 5, 4

1. Fruit Pie - 1 pie displayed in a disposable tin pie pan, wrapped in plastic wrap, recipe must be included
2. Quick Breads – 1 loaf approx.1 pound, recipe in plastic
3. Cake - 1 round or sheet cake, not iced, wrapped in plastic wrap, approximately 1 pound, recipe must be included

Dept 49 Section 2 & 3 - 4-H & FFA Exhibitors

Division 1 - Honey \$5, 4, 3

Classes

1. Light Cut Comb - 3 sections, displayed in clear plastic box
2. Dark Cut Comb - 3 sections, displayed in clear plastic box
3. Light Amber Extracted - Pfund 85 or less, 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers
4. Dark Amber Extracted - Pfund 86 or more, 3 lbs, display in 1 lb glass containers

Division 2 - Beeswax - Exhibit not less than 1 and not more than 3 pounds \$5, 4, 3

Classes

1. Single Piece of Pure Beeswax
2. Molded or Designed - artistic/fancy/candle
